The Department of Clinical and Administrative Sciences at California Northstate University College of Pharmacy (CNUCOP) has an opening for a faculty position at the Assistant, Associate or Full Professor level as an Experiential Education Area Coordinator (EEAC) in beautiful San Diego, California. The Experiential Education program employs a 12-month, full-time, non-tenure track clinical faculty, funded entirely by the College. Rank and salary will be commensurate with experience.

As a member of the faculty, EEACs share the same rights and responsibilities as all other on-campus faculty of the College. EEACs have a significant administrative component to their responsibilities which includes the coordination of student experiential activities at one of the College's geographic "hubs". EEACs lead "experiential summits" as part of the educational process for students on rotation in keeping with the College's team-based learning (TBL) philosophy throughout the program. EEACs are assisted by a full and well-developed staff in the Experiential Education program, including the Associate Dean for Experiential Education. EEACs have allocated funds for travel and professional development and report to the Chair for the Department of Clinical and Administrative Sciences.

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The successful candidate will have completed a terminal practice degree (e.g., PharmD) from an ACPE-accredited College of Pharmacy. Eligibility for pharmacy licensure in the State of California attained within 4 months from the date of hire is required. The successful candidate will have excellent verbal and written communication skills, experience in infectious disease and maintain an active practice in his/her area of expertise. Preference is given to candidates who have completed an ASHP-accredited infectious disease residency (PGY2) and/or specialized training (e.g. fellowship, stewardship experience), as well as acquired Board Certification.

The "hub" is based in San Diego, CA, with the primary practice site located at Sharp Chula Vista Hospital. Sharp HealthCare has received the Malcolm Baldridge National Quality Award and has been recognized by the Ethisphere Institute as a 2014 World's Most Ethical Company.
