

# Pseudomonas aeruginosa Mechanisms of Resistance

mexAB-oprM

ampC

Episode #59: Resistance in Pseudomonas aeruginosa: Pearls and Perils

Efflux pumps: β-lactams and aminoglycosides most affected

- mexR repressor gene mutation increases expression of mexAB-oprM (cefepime, ceftazidime, piperacillin, and meropenem)
- Relebactam less likely to be effluxed than avibactam
- mexXY induction of aminoglycoside resistance

### Porin channel mutations:

- oprD: carbapenems (imipenem > meropenem)
- oprF: low-level, broad β-lactam effect

### Beta-lactamases:

- ampC: can hydrolyze most antipseudomonal β-lactams
  - Over expression is a major mechanism of resistance for piperacillin-tazobactam and ceftazidime
  - Mutations in the catalytic center of ampC can lead to ceftolozane-tazobactam and ceftazidime-avibactam resistance
- Induced by: imipenem, piperacillin, and tazobactam
- Inhibited by: avibactam, relebactam
- KPC, GES, metallo-β-lactamases: less common but heavily dependent on geographic region

### Penicillin binding protein site mutations:

- · Less common than other resistance mechanisms.
- PBP3 increases MIC to cefepime, aztreonam, and meropenem
- PBP4 major ampC regulator, mutation causes ampC overexpression
- PBP5 most common PBP, can function as a β-lactamase enzyme

### Takeawav:

- Local epidemiology is important for predicting resistance mechanisms in Pseudomonas aeruginosa
- Knowledge of underlying resistance mechanisms is important for determining optimal treatment

# **Toolkits and Other Educational Materials**

SIDP has the expertise and reach to provide education related to a variety of infectious diseases and related therapies. Educational materials can be developed to target any audience, including but not limited to, physicians, pharmacists, nurses, and patients.

### **Toolkits**

### \$100,000-\$150,000

Example: In 2022, SIDP developed a **COVID-19 Oral Antiviral Toolkit** that features information about the available COVID-19 oral antivirals, a decision tree to guide patient screening, resources to assist with prescribing, and educational resources for nurses, providers, and patients.

5-month metrics from the toolkit launch to February 2023 include:

- 1351 non-SIDP member registered resource users (SIDP members do not need to register to access the materials)
- 1990 unique pageviews
- 583 total downloads

# Social Media Educational Posts

### \$2,000-\$5,000 per post

Price varies based on complexity of the post and time of the year (e.g., during major conferences)

Collaborate with SIDP to develop educational posts that can be shared across any social media platform. Content may be posted on the SIDP or the Company's social media account.



The SIDP newsletter is a quarterly electronic publication that reaches over 1,700 SIDP members through e-mail.

Four 'first ads' are available each year and will be sold first-come, first-served. Please inquire about available quarters

Newsletter Advertisement Specifications

- · Image specifications:
  - Image Width: minimum 800 px, maximum 1000 px
  - Image Height: maximum 1000px
- Hyperlink (when image is clicked)

  - Up to 150 words or 25 lines, whichever is shorter
  - Text will be formatted to match the newsletter colors, fonts, etc.

### Website Sponsorship/Grant

### \$10,000 per year

Over the past year (Jan 1, 2022 – Dec 31, 2022), there were over 85,000 website users and over 133,000 website visits (session views). On average, users are visiting at least 2 unique pages per visit (over 230,000 unique page views). The toolikits had over 7,400 views combined. Based on the geolocation tracker, there were visits from 183 countries and territories. Visit sidp.org to learn more.

### \$20,000-\$100,000

SIDP is dedicated to supporting high-quality, unbiased clinical research. Research may target specific disease states and/or topics (e.g., rapid diagnostics), but SIDP cannot guarantee the use of licensed products. Many projects are presented at national infectious diseases conferences and published in high-impact journals.

### **Review Process**

- Committee consists of 20 active members with significant research experience along with 3 trainee members
- Grants are reviewed and scored in accordance with National Institutes of Health Review Criteria
